I affirm that I understand and will abide by all other rules and regulations of the enrollment at the Technical College of the Lowcountry. I have reviewed the Academic Policies, Procedures, and Expectations featured in TCL's Dual Enrollment Handbook that govern participation in classes at the Technical College of the Lowcountry.

Fiscal Responsibility:

I understand that a portion of my tuition will be paid by SC Lottery Tuition Assistance (LTA) every academic year while in Dual Enrollment at the Technical College of the Lowcountry. I understand that funding is not available for all programs in the academic year and will be determined on a program or case-by-case basis. Associated fees (textbooks and course cost fees) are excluded from Lottery coverage. I understand it is my responsibility to determine if financial liability falls with myself and/or my parent/guardian, or with my high school. By completing the enrollment process, I acknowledge and agree to fulfill any financial liability accrued during my Dual Enrollment tenure. After high school, I will seek other sources of funding, such as LIFE Scholarship, SC WINS/Lottery Tuition Assistance, or other state and federal financial aid.

I understand that accepting LTA funding and earning a certificate toward my technical program may prevent me from being eligible to receive LTA funds for a program not associated toward my pathway for five years after earning my certificate. For example, if I receive a Designing HVAC Systems certificate but plan to seek a certificate or associate degree in a program in a different area (criminal justice, nursing, etc.), I may not be eligible for LTA funding toward that program.

I understand that LTA is a state-funded program based on a GPA of at least 2.0 after a student earns 24 credit hours, and is assessed prior to each fall term for the upcoming academic year. I understand this is different from federal financial aid's requirement of Satisfactory Academic Progress, which requires a 2.0 GPA, 67% completion rate, and a maximum of 150% program-required credit hours, and is assessed at the end of every semester.

In order to receive Lottery Tuition assistance, you must be a U.S. citizen or a permanent resident that meets the definition of an eligible non-citizen. Students that are considered to have "legal presence" under the "Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals" also known as DACA, do not qualify for Lottery tuition assistance funds. Out-of-state, or non-resident, charges are assessed and disbursed for students who do not meet in-state residency requirements.

I acknowledge this agreement is required for my initial registration and must be submitted annually in order to maintain enrollment.
