



Licensure Exams for Annual Reporting 2023

Annually, the results of professional licensure exams are collected and reported to the Commission on Higher Education (CHE). The SCTCS Chief Academic Officers (CAO) Peer Group has reviewed and recommended licensure exams that should be reported for the 16 colleges. Exams that are not a program requirement and exams available only via self-reported data have been excluded from the exam list. The collection of results data for professional examinations should include first-time test takers for those students who completed an examination during the period of April 1, 2022 through March 31, 2023.
